
PRECAUTIONS

Warning: Unless directed otherwise, the ignition and start switch must be in the OFF or LOCK position, and all electrical loads must be OFF before servicing any electrical component. Disconnect the battery ground cable to prevent an electrical spark should a tool or equipment come in contact with an exposed electrical terminal. Failure to follow these precautions may result in personal injury and/or damage to the vehicle or its components.

BATTERY

Removal

1. Record all vehicle preset radio stations.
2. Turn OFF all lamps and accessories.
3. Ensure ignition switch is in OFF position.
4. Remove luggage compartment floor trim panel.
5. Remove battery trim cover.
6. Disconnect battery ground cable.
7. Unlock positive battery terminal cover (2) and remove, **Fig. 1**.
8. Remove positive battery cable nut (3).




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Fig. 1 Positive battery terminal cover

9. Disconnect positive battery cable (1).
10. Remove battery hold down bolt and battery hold down, **Fig. 2**.
11. Disconnect battery vent hose.
12. Remove battery.

Installation

1. Install battery.
2. Install battery hold down and screw. **Torque** hold down screw to 92 inch lbs.
3. Install battery vent hose.
4. Connect positive battery cable to bat-

- tery. **Torque** battery cable to 92 inch lbs.
5. Connect battery ground cable. **Torque** battery cable to 19 ft. lbs.
6. Remove battery trim cover.
7. Remove luggage compartment floor trim panel.
8. Set clock and program radio stations back into radio as recorded at beginning of procedure.

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
