PRECAUTIONS

The battery surface (particularly its top) should always be kept clean and dry.

The terminal connections should be clean and tight.

When battery cable is disconnected from ground terminal or when battery voltage becomes 10V or less, setting of automatic temperature control switch, automatic drive positioner, power window control, rear view monitor and automatic back door system memory functions may be cancelled. Re-setting of these systems may be required.

BATTERY Removal

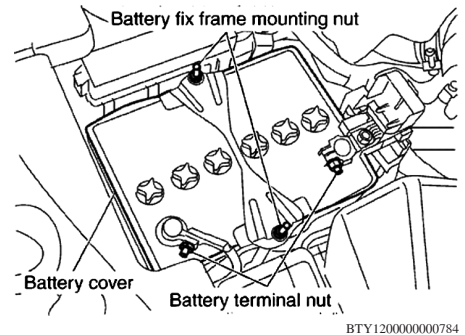


Fig. 1 Battery removal

1. Disconnect battery ground terminal

and positive battery terminal. When disconnecting, disconnect battery ground terminal first, **Fig. 1**.

2. Remove battery fix frame mounting nuts and battery fix frame.
3. Remove battery cover.
4. Remove battery.

Installation

1. Install battery.
2. Install battery cover.
3. Install battery fix frame.
4. **Torque** battery fix frame mounting nuts to 35 inch lbs.
5. Connect positive battery terminal and battery ground terminal. When connecting, connect battery cable to positive terminal first.
6. **Torque** battery terminal nuts to 48 inch lbs.
