PRECAUTIONS

BATTERY Removal

1. Remove battery cover.

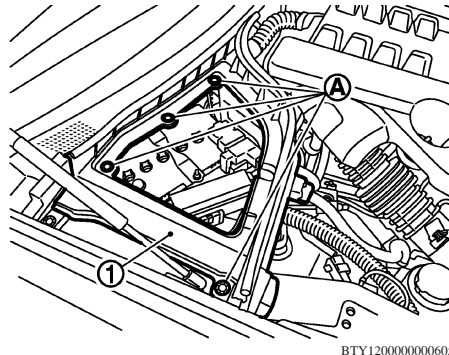


Fig. 1 Righthand hoodledge cover removal

2. Remove clips (A), and remove righthand hoodledge cover (1), **Fig. 1**.
3. Remove righthand cowl top cover.
4. Remove cover on battery positive terminal.

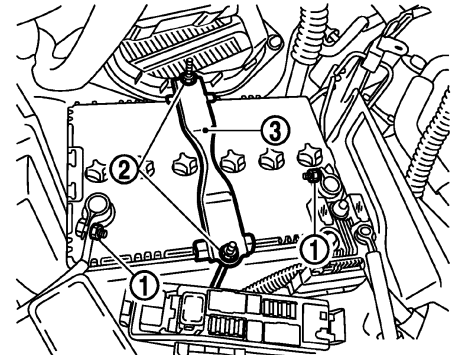


Fig. 2 Battery removal

5. Loosen battery cable clamp nuts (1), disconnect battery ground cable first, then disconnect positive cable from battery terminals, **Fig. 2**.
6. Remove mounting nuts (2), and remove battery hold down (3), **Fig. 2**.
7. Remove battery.

Installation

1. Reverse procedure to install, noting the following:
 - a. **Torque** battery hold down mounting nuts to 35 inch lbs.
 - b. Connect battery positive cable to battery first, then connect battery ground cable.
 - c. **Torque** battery cable clamp nuts to 48 inch lbs.
 - d. Reset electronic systems as required.
